

SUMMER READING

You have the ability to choose from over 150,000 titles from the AR database which can be accessed from any computer. Selected titles can be borrowed from the local libraries. Specific step-by-step directions are included, and Mrs. Schwemmer will help you with any questions. You will need to read a book which falls into the appropriate ATOS range and totals the number of required points.

- Students entering grade 7—4.3 through 7.5 and 10 points
 - Students entering grade 8—4.5 through 8.0 and 10 points
 - Students entering grade 9—4.6 through 9.0 and 11 points
 - Students entering grade 10—4.7 through 10.0 and 11 points
 - Students entering grade 11—4.8 through 11.0 and 12 points
 - Students entering grade 12—4.9 through 12.0 and 12 points
- There will be an assessment—September 2nd for students in grade 7, 8, or 9, and on September 3rd for students in grade 10, 11, or 12.
 - Students wishing to borrow novels or take the test(s) earlier may do so either on August 13th or August 18th from 8 am-11:30 am in the High School library.
 - This assessment will count as a grade in the English class.

You may not take a test for a novel taught to you during the course of the school year. For example, an incoming high school student can not take an AR test for Lord of the Flies as it was taught in 8th grade. Please see/email your teacher if you have any questions.
