- Authorized the Avalon Borough and Bellevue Borough real estate tax collectors to levy a \$10.00 administrative fee for each duplicate bill and a \$10.00 research fee for each year of tax information requested by banks, mortgage companies, closing companies, and other similar companies.
- Approved a 36-month lease agreement with AMASTI for the provision of DM400C Digital Meter Postage Systems in the Administrative Center and Middle/High School office.
- Approved the following use of facility requests:

 - 1) Approved the request of the Bellevue 6th grade parents to use Bellevue Elementary gym for Family Fun Night from 5:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. on Friday, January 11, 2013, as a fundraiser for the Washington, D.C. trip.
 - 2) Approved the Bellevue PTO's request to use the Bellevue Elementary gym for a dance on Friday, May 31, 2013, at 4:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. for a fundraiser for the Washington, D.C. trip.
 - 3) Approved the request of the Bellevue 6th grade parents to use the Middle/High School swimming pool one night on a Friday evening between the dates of December 14, 2012 to January 4, 2013, or December 7 if available, from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. as a fundraiser for the Washington, D.C. trip, contingent upon them hiring their own lifeguards.
 - b) Approved the request of the Bellevue PTO to use the Bellevue Elementary gym on Thursday, February 21, 2013, or an alternate date of Thursday, February 28, 2013, from 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. for a "Minute to Win It" fundraiser.

 - Approved Avalon Elementary and Bellevue Elementary to participate in the Dental Sealant Program through the Allegheny County Health Department, which is through a state funded grant, at no cost to the District or students. The program currently exists for second graders and is now expanded to sixth graders.
 - Approved a Memorandum of Understanding with Midwestern Intermediate Unit IV for e-mail hosting and anti-spam filtering during the 2012-2013 school year.
