

BOARD HIGHLIGHTS

September 16, 2014

Northgate Staff,

Dr. Pasquerilla commented that the Elementary Open Houses went well. He also mentioned the upcoming Middle/High School Open House for September 18.

The Board approved the following items at their September 15, 2014 Board meeting:

- Approved the following use of facility requests:
 - a. Approved the request of the North Boroughs Tidal Waves Swim Team to use the Northgate Middle/High School Swimming Pool for spring clinic from 3:15 to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday from May 18 to May 29, 2015.
 - b. Approved the request of the Bellevue 6th grade parents to use Bellevue Elementary auditorium from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. from Monday to Thursday, October 6 - 9, 2014, for a book fair as a fundraiser for the Washington, D.C. trip. Also, the Board approved their request to use the auditorium on Friday, October 3, 2014, for setup.
 - c. Approved the request of the Pittsburgh Poison All Stars to use the Middle/High School gym on Saturday, October 25, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. for their dance team preseason dress rehearsal.
 - d. Approved a request by the Pittsburgh Spirit to use the Dilmore-Mayernik Softball Field for its games and practices and their request to use the indoor batting cage area, provided that the District has no plans to use this area.
 - e. Approved a request of the Winter Ensemble to use the Middle/High School gym, cafeteria, first and second floor hallways on Friday, February 20, 2015, from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. to set up for the show, and Saturday, February 21, 2015, from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. to host their annual show.
 - f. Approved the request of the Bellevue 6th grade parents to use Bellevue Elementary gym for a dance on Wednesday, October 29, 2014, from 4:30 to 9:30 p.m. as a fundraiser for the Washington, D.C. trip.
 - g. Approved a request from the Bellevue-Avalon Girls' Athletic Association (BAGAA) to use the Bellevue Elementary gym on Tuesday and Friday evenings when available, October 21, 2014 to February 27, 2015 from 6:00 – 9:00 p.m. and Saturdays from October 25, 2014 to February 28, 2015 from 9:00 a.m. to noon.

- Approved the attendance of up to 8 students and 1 advisor to attend the State Student Council Conference at Altoona High School on November 6 – 8, 2014, at an approximate cost not to exceed \$500 for transportation only.
- Accepted the resignation of Sarah Wilt as Art Club Sponsor. The Board also accepted the resignation of Candice Shaughnessy as Elementary Choral Director.
- Accepted the resignation of Jessica Molnar as First Assistant Girls' Basketball Coach. The Board also accepted the resignation of Anthony Barron as Middle School Boys' Basketball Coach.
- Approved the Treasurer's Reports, Bill Lists and Tax Refunds.
- Accepted Avalon Borough's action to accept the donation of a property (Block & Lot 214-M-52 on Semple Avenue) in lieu of taxes owed to it, which will divest all outstanding taxes and liens of other local taxing bodies. In this case the School District has no outstanding liens or taxes owed on this property.
- Approved issuing a Bellevue Elementary Master key to Sharon Trimmer.
- Approved the request of a custodian for an unpaid leave of absence.
- Approved two part-time teacher assistants for 25 hours a week each.
